MINISTRIES

1. **Annual Meeting**— Celebration of Churches highlighting ministries, historical events, etc.
2. **Big Hatchie Counseling Center**, (housed in the association office and an extension of ministry to our churches and community) Kimberly Kellum, LPC & Gerald Wood, MS., LPC—Counseling Assistance payments are provided to counselor/s as needed by association for those in need of counseling without insurance or ability to pay.
3. **Big Hatchie Youth Camp** - Usually falls on the first full week of June at Rose of Sharon Campground, Burlison, TN. (allowing smaller churches to be able to afford sending their groups to camp and allowing all youth groups large and small to connect with area students within our churches.)
4. **Collection point** for various ministries at different or simultaneous times: Disaster Relief: Buckets for Haiti, Desserts for officers at West Tennessee Penitentiary, Disaster Relief trained contacts, Boy's Ranch Food Shower gifts, grocery bags collected and recycled to make homeless mats, used Christian literature /Sunday School / etc. collected for Love Packages Ministry and shipped to missionaries around the world.
5. **Disaster Relief**— Opportunities for Trained Volunteers to assist after disaster hits.
6. **WMU**—Mission Education, Quarterly Meetings & Projects.
7. **Minister's Fellowship**—meet most Mondays at 10:30 am followed with lunch at local restaurant. Additionally a Christmas Dinner is planned each year for the Ministers & Spouses.
8. **Mission Trip Opportunities (yearly) & Supported BHBA Partnership Missions**—This fiscal year a week long Denver Church Plant Mission trip is planned in July. Your gifts to the Big Hatchie Baptist Association help support an **Idaho Church Plant** (Pastor, Scott Plath, member of a Big Hatchie Church, Cornerstone began this new work in Idaho), **Mississippi River Ministry**—Various forms of assistance focusing on poverty ministries or projects.
9. **Newsletter - Herald**— Sent out monthly to church members as requested via email, mailed or available on our website. This publicizes many church events & celebrations, as well as publicizing local and regional training opportunities for churches (ie: Revivals, VBS's, Homecoming, Ordinations, etc.)
10. **Website**— www.bighatchiebaptist.org - Promoting BHBA Churches
11. **Pocket New Testament Bibles**— Purchased & supplied for Big Hatchie WMU "New Testaments for Newborns" ministry to mothers who deliver at Baptist Memorial Hospital Tipton.
12. **Baptist Collegiate Ministry at Dyersburg State Community College**— Jimmy Naifeh Center at Tipton County. Reaching out to students on campus with Coffee Connections, Lunch Encounters, and worship services.
13. **Training and Outreach Events: ongoing and as needed**, such as: Evangelism, Discipleship, Sunday School, Clerk, Disaster Relief, Financial Issues Facing Churches, Mission Trips, Associational Crusades, Rallies, Prayer Conferences, & etc.
14. **Hispanic Mission Work**—Hispanic church planter has begun outreach.

6. **Teddy Evans Mission Fund**—This fund was set up to assist and allow Big Hatchie Church members to experience short term missions. Most gifts range from \$250 to \$500.
7. **Youth Ministry Scholarship**—For a Big Hatchie member who has surrendered to the call to Youth Ministry and is going to College / Seminary to equip themselves toward leading Youth.

1. **Director of Missions**, Bro. Clay Gilbreath, available to Pastors & Churches for encouragement, assistance, suggestions, council and for various needs within the churches such as: Ordinations, Supply Preaching, Training for Pastor Search Committees, Church Conflict Management, mediation of Business Meetings, etc. He also represents the Big Hatchie churches to the Tennessee Baptist Convention, SBC and other entities.
2. **Ministry Assistant**—Cindy James, available to support church staff by answering ministry / office questions or give connections to people who specialize in the area of needed assistance, gather, print, pull church historical & statistical reports by church request, collect resume's for ministry positions for churches, Provides accounting for BHBA & various ministries such as Teddy Evans Mission Fund, Camp Hatchie, D-Now and various mission projects, trips and new works as needed and able.
3. **Office Assistant**—Bobbie Timberlake works part time at the association. She assists with the monthly Herald Newsletter, collects Annual Church Profile data prior to annual meeting and assists with various office tasks and projects as needed.
